Volunteer Opportunities

Enrich your experience with Congregation Ner Tamid by choosing an opportunity to volunteer your time and expertise:

Clean Up – After a service or other event, stay to straighten up.

Fundraising – Plan and coordinate one or more fundraising activities.

Programming – Plan a program or special event.

Publicity – Help to generate publicity by contacting newspapers, radio stations, etc., by sending out flyers and other mailings, and by creating new ideas for letting people know about our activities.

T’Filah (Ritual) – Plan for member participation in Shabbat and holiday services. Contact members to offer opportunities to be part of the service. Congregants may read prayers in English or Hebrew, prepare a D’var Torah (sermon), lead part of a service, or suggest songs or prayers.

Sunday School – Support the *Jewish Living and Learning Sunday School* by assisting with one or two projects, such as baking or crafts.

Telephone Squad – Call members as needed to remind them of services and events. Email is a definite plus for this committee.

Tikkun Olam (Social Services) – Plan and coordinate ways for our membership to serve the community and the world.

Transportation – Organize rides to services and events for people who do not drive.

The mission of *Congregation Ner Tamid* is to create a Jewish community that encourages participation in meaningful Jewish worship, accepts diverse Jewish backgrounds and interfaith families, provides Jewish education for children and adults, celebrates all life cycle events, and initiates opportunities for committed social action (*tikkun olam*), all for a modest membership fee.
